Event Venue Descriptions:

Slopestyle – The slopestyle event will be held on Upper Terrain Park. Lift access is provided by the Kangamangas Quad located outside the Competition Center. The Loon Mountain Slopestyle course has something for every athlete. The course will consist of fourteen elements, including four airs suitable for spread eagle to off axis maneuvers.

Moguls – The mogul event will be held on Lower Flume. Lift access is provided by the North Peak Chair Lift. The course will be approximately 160 meters with four air bumps suitable for all ages.

Aerials – The aerials event will be held in Little Sister Terrain Park. Lift access is provided by the Little Sister Chair Lift or Seven Brothers Chair Lift. The aerial hill will consist of four upright kickers from 35-footer, 25-footer, 12-footer and 4-footer which should make for an exciting aerial event.

Directions to:

The Mountain Club: When you pull into Loon Mountain, go over bridge, and take left at stop sign. Travel past the Adventure Center, the Real Estate Office and the Octagon Lodge and then you will see The Mountain Club. Parking is for guests only so you will need to drive back down to regular parking lots after you register.

Governor Adams Lodge: This is a base lodge located at the base of Loon Mtn near the Kangamangus Express Quad.

Special Note:

SINCE THERE IS PARKING AVAILABLE FOR GUESTS ONLY AT THE MOUNTAIN CLUB, parents will need to drive back to mtn parking lots after registering and checking in their athletes each day. HOWEVER, ATHLETES AND COACHES are allowed to get ready for skiing in the KINSMAN ROOM. They are also allowed to leave their bags there for the day.
