Lift Tickets

Athletes will receive lift tickets for all competition days in which they have registered. Competitor training tickets can be purchased on any day you plan to train from March $19^{th} - 21^{st}$ for \$40. To purchase training tickets, please come to the registration area at the Training Center.

Parents and siblings can receive discounted lift tickets as well. The cost will be \$40 each on Thursday and Friday and \$50 each on Saturday and Sunday. Parent tickets will be available at the Training Center during normal registration times or the Resort Service Center (located adjacent to Holiday Valley Lodge). Lodging guests of the Inn at Holiday Valley or Tamarack will be able to purchase parent/sibling tickets at the front desk of each establishment. Another reason to stay on the slopes!

Since Holiday Valley has skiing until 10PM each night. Any 8 hour comp ticket or 8 hour parent ticket can be taken to the ticket booths and extended for night skiing at ½ price of the regular night ticket price.

All coaches will be required to sign in at the Mountain Sports Center (Training Center) each day for tickets or at Registration at the Main Lodge on Sunday.

Lodging

The Inn at Holiday Valley is offering a rate of \$129 for Non Slope view rooms and \$139 for Slope view Rooms with two beds includes a continental Buffet Breakfast. Weekday or weekend nights are the same rate. These units are ski in and ski out. See other benefits under lift tickets.
